Finishes long, saline and slightly phenolic but pure, making this one of the finest Sauvignon Blancs produced in Austria. A special selection from vineyard blocks that were planted in 1967, 1951 and 1937, it is matured for about three years in old oak casks and released late in an old Rhine bottle that the estate once used long ago.

#### Weingut Neumeister



"Two thousand thirteen is the best vintage I have ever made," said Christoph Neumeister, who is not known to mince words. While I group his estate with all of the others from Styria, it is technically in Southeastern Styria. The weather here is generally a touch warmer and drier than in Southern Styria, where most of the better-known producers are located. As a result, his wines are less ostentatiously fruity and a touch more compact, and often need more time to open.

Neumeister, who came back to the estate in 2001, now runs the show with the help of his younger brother Matthias. In that time, they have gradually extended their vineyard holdings, scaled back grape purchases and begun converting to organic farming. With relatively long macerations, and the use of wild yeasts and higher temperatures during fermentation, their wines are more phenolic and structured than those of their colleagues but they age well. And even when the Neumeisters harvest late, their wines are seldom high in alcohol.

While their Sauvignon Blancs are generally among my favorites in any given vintage, Pinot Gris--and in particular the Saziani--is gradually becoming the estate's signature wine.
